## Aims and objectives

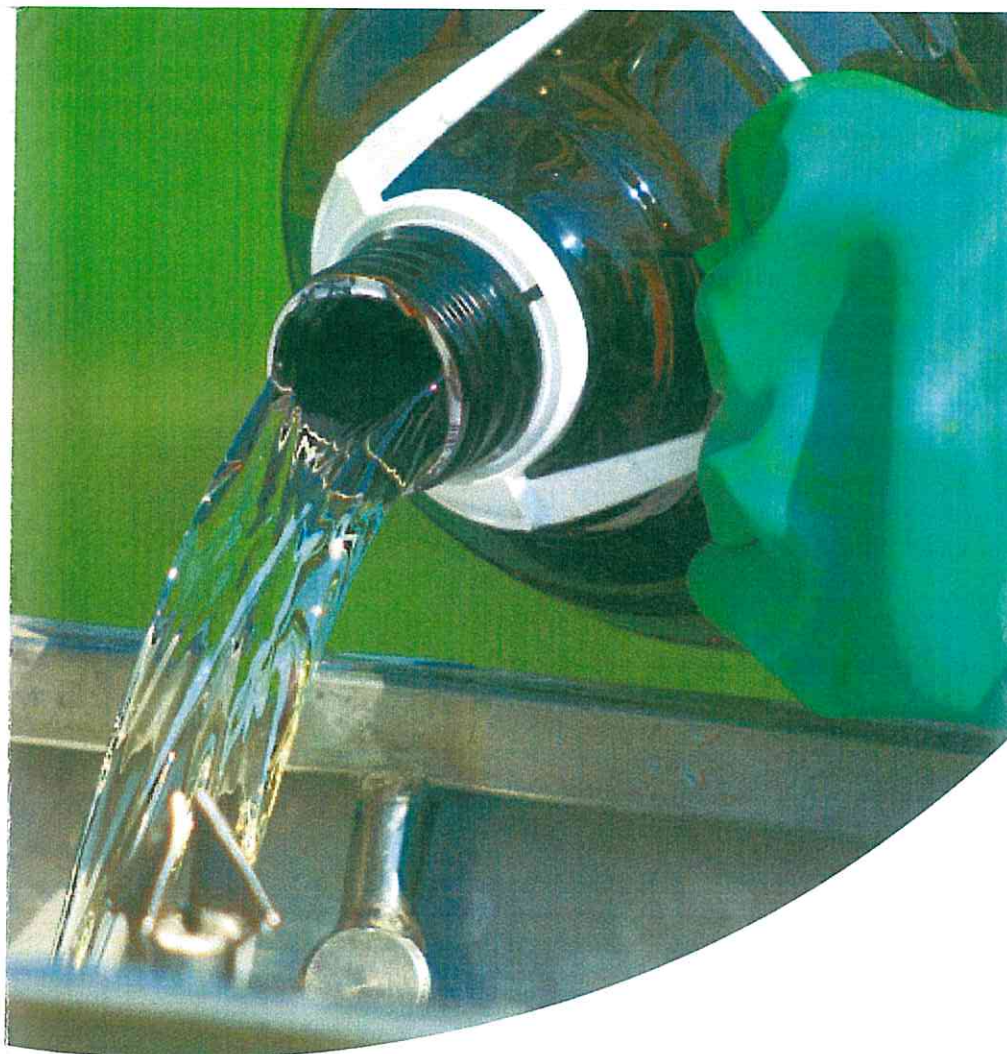

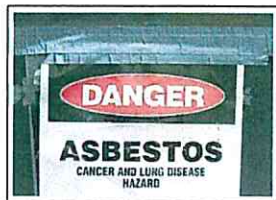
