Hazardous materials safety training

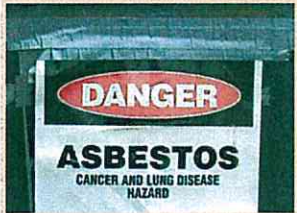
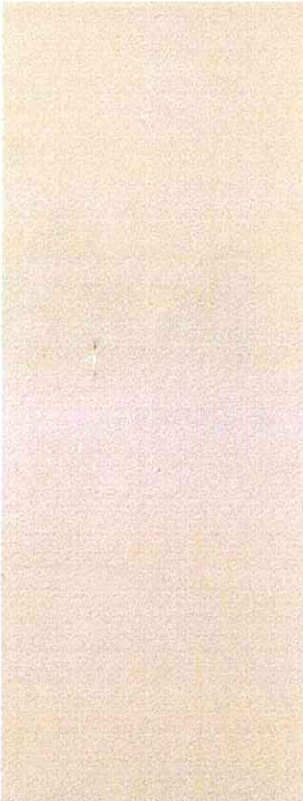
1. An understanding of what hazardous substances are and the risk associated with them in an incident.
